### What is a Victim Impact Panel?

A nonjudgmental forum for impaired driving victims/survivors to share their stories with DUI offenders about the physical, emotional and financial impact of an impaired driving crash on their lives, their families and the communities. All speakers are volunteers.

Classes are approximately two hours long. Funds enable MADD to serve victims and survivors throughout Idaho and support underage drinking prevention programs.

This program provides a unique opportunity for awareness, thus influencing a reduction in recidivism.
